## EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE CITY MANAGER TERMINATING THE DECLARED STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY IN RESPONSE TO CITY WIDE THREAT FROM HURRICANE ESTABLISHED IN CM-EO 2024-01

The following Executive Order was adopted by the City Manager of the City of Melbourne, Florida on the date written below.

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2024 and October 6, 2024 the Governor of the State of Florida issued Executive Order Numbers 2024-214 and 2024-215, declaring that a State of Emergency exists in certain counties in the State of Florida located throughout the State, including Brevard County and the City of Melbourne area as a result of the imminent threat of injury and damage from Hurricane Milton; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18-23 of Melbourne City Code, upon the Governor's said declaration of emergency, the City Manager issued CM-EO 2024-01, declaring a state of local emergency due to substantial harm for Hurricane Milton beginning at 6:00 am on Wednesday October 9, 2024 and extending for seven (7) days; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 18-23(d) of the Melbourne City Code, the City Manager desires to terminate the declared state of local emergency due to substantial harm for Hurricane Milton effective at 4:00 pm on Thursday, October 10, 2024.

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, FLORIDA THIS 10<sup>th</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2024:

SECTION 1: That the declared state of local emergency due to substantial harm as initiated by City Manager Executive Order CM-EO 2024-01 is hereby terminated.

SECTION 2: That this Executive Order shall take effect at 4:00 pm on Thursday, October 10, 2024.
