**Re:** Ordinance No. 2025-12 – Camping on Public Property Corrective Ordinance

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### **Summary of the Proposed Ordinance**

This proposed ordinance intends to serve the public purpose of ensuring the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the City by correcting an error in Ordinance No. 2025-08 regarding the definition of “camping” for Section 52-10, City Code regarding prohibiting camping on public property. This Business Impact Estimate is provided in accordance with Section 166.041(4), Florida Statutes, and may be revised following its initial publication and prior to adoption of the proposed ordinance.

### **Estimate of Direct Economic Impact of the Proposed Ordinance on Private, For-Profit Businesses**

There are no known direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur if the ordinance is passed.

There are no new charges or fees on businesses subject to the proposed ordinance, or for which businesses will be financially responsible.

Costs for the City’s regulatory enforcement are unknown and cannot be reasonably estimated at this time.

### **Good Faith Estimate of Number of Businesses Likely to Be Impacted by the Proposed Ordinance**

The proposed ordinance deals with activities within rights-of-way and City property. Any impact to businesses by the proposed ordinance is secondary, and does not implicate negative enforcement possibilities for businesses.
